EVIDENCE BASE

- Children are more likely to retain learning if this is accompanied by positive reinforcement and praise (Stephenson & Kumar, 2008)
- Between four and six sessions optimises the benefits of the training for children (Whelan et al, 2008)
- Certificates marking the completion of the intervention are not advisable (Stephenson & Kumar, 2008)
- A practical element to the training allows the children to put learning into practice and is considerably more effective than simple information-giving. (Whelan et al, 2008; Stephenson & Kumar, 2008)

PILOT STUDY

- 60 Year 3 pupils
- Small increase in numbers walking to school
- Small increase in confidence of road safety knowledge
- Improvement in Knowledge of visibility, GCC, Crossings
- Improvement in route choice and critical thinking
- Increased learning for those who practiced
- Outstanding feedback from school
